A CIS staff member who notices a child scratching their head continuously (often behind the ears and around the hairline) or who sees live nits or eggs in a child's hair will report it to the office immediately.

The school will call the parents/guardians and it will be necessary for them to pick the student up immediately for home treatment.

The child may return to school once the treatment has been given and the nits and eggs are removed.
