About the School:

Canadian International School Bangladesh (CISB) offers a unique dual track program; Nova Scotia High School Diploma and IB Diploma Programmes.

CISB is a Canadian accredited school by the Ministry of Education, Nova Scotia, Canada and also by the IBO. There are many private schools in Dhaka, Bangladesh but only one that offers a comprehensive certified Nova Scotia, Canada course of studies. Meeting the needs of students academically as well as holistically - is the goal of CISB.

Students who are pursuing IB Diploma Programme at CISB will receive two diploma certificates: one from Nova Scotia Department of Education and the other from the International Baccalaureate Organization (IBO). On the other hand, students following Nova Scotia programme, will be able to combine courses from both programmes; IBDP and Nova Scotia as per their interest.

Since 2005 the Canadian International School Bangladesh has been committed to high quality education that nurtures the mind and body of all students as they pursue academic excellence. Our graduates are creative and innovative thinkers and are ready to take any challenge this allows them to get admission into top ranked universities around the world. At CISB our curriculum is structured in such a way that we prepare students through our **2-year Pre-University studies** for admissions into the prestigious universities in Canada and around the world.



About Pre-University Studies:

We are a Canadian Accredited School and approved IB World School strictly following the Nova Scotia Curriculum as well IB Diploma Programme. Our campus facilities and resources fully support a **2-Year Pre-University Programme** equipping our students with the required knowledge and skills. They receive a Diploma either from Nova Scotia, Canada or from IBO which leads to direct admission into Canadian universities as well as universities in different corners of the world.

Pre-University Studies:

From Grade 10 we equip students with the skills for the 2-year Pre-University studies, preparing them for the academic rigors of university. Our Pre-University studies are from Grade 11 – Grade 12, acting as a bridge for the students, leading them directly to the Universities globally.



NOVA SCOTIA GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

A high school graduation diploma is issued by the Department of Education and Early Childhood. Development and is awarded to students who have successfully completed the graduation requirements as described below. Students require a minimum of 18 credits to graduate. The following are compulsory credits for graduation:

MANDATORY SUBJECTS

- Mathematics 10, Mathematics 11, Mathematics 12,
- English 10, English 11, English 12,
- Canadian History 11, Global Geography 12,
- 2 Sciences,
- P.E., Visual Art 10, Tech/Mathematics/Science
- 5 more optional subjects
- They must have 5 subjects at grade 12 level courses.

INTERNATIONAL BACCALAUREATE PROGRAMME (IBDP) REQUIREMENTS:

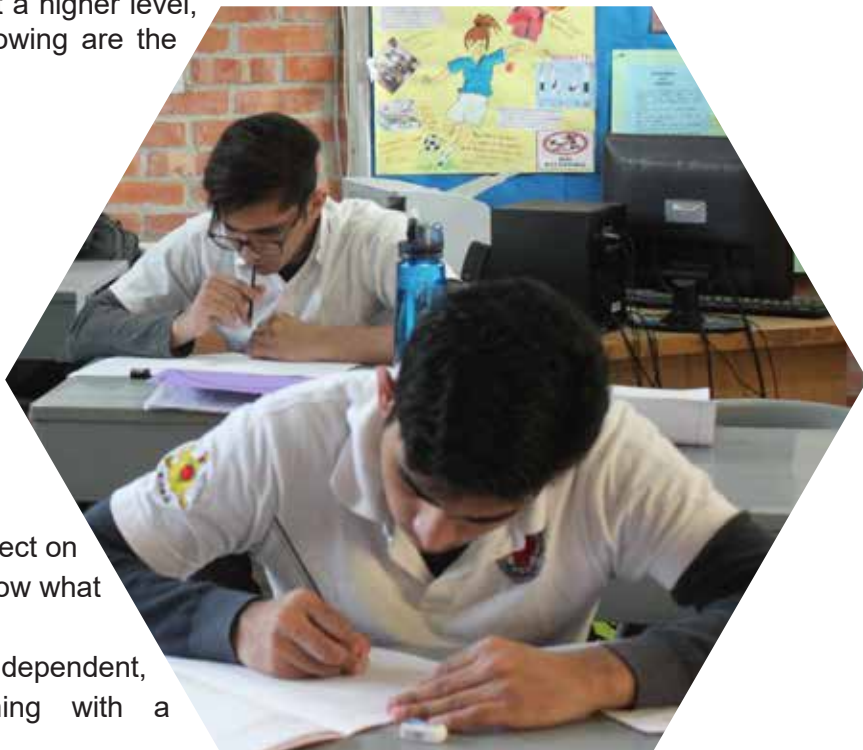
In the DP, the curriculum consists of six subject groups and the three elements of the DP core. There are different courses within each subject group and the three required components; theory of knowledge; extended essay; and creativity, activity, service (CAS). The DP core aims to broaden students' educational experience and challenge them to apply their knowledge and skills. Each student takes at least three (but not more than four) subjects at a higher level, and the remaining at standard level. The following are the subject groups.

The six subject groups are:

- Studies in language and literature
- Language acquisition
- Individuals and societies
- Sciences
- Mathematics
- The arts

The three core elements are:

- Theory of knowledge, in which students reflect on the nature of knowledge and on how we know what we claim to know.
- The extended essay, which is an independent, self-directed piece of research, finishing with a 4,000-word paper.
- Creativity, activity, service, in which students complete a project related to those three concepts.



Requirements for admission into Pre-University studies at CISB:

Students from SSC, O' Level or any other equivalent qualifications are welcome to join our campus. Along with an assessment designed by our professionals, student transcripts are sent to Nova Scotia Department of Education for credit eligibility.

When can students enroll?

We offer rolling admissions meaning there is no strict deadline to enroll in CISB to the Nova Scotia curriculum however, for IBDP enrolment ends in September.

What textbooks are appropriate for the Canadian Curriculum?

For effective implementation of Canadian Curriculum, our textbooks are recommended by the Nova Scotia Department of Education and IBO hence all our textbooks are imported from Nova Scotia, Canada or acquired from the IBO.

What role does CISB play in getting admissions in Universities?

Being a Canadian accredited high school, every year we have representatives from well-known universities visiting our campus during admission period. They hold sessions to discuss with our faculty and students the admission procedure and information which is crucial and beneficial for admission. Our school also has academic counselors who provide necessary support in the following steps:

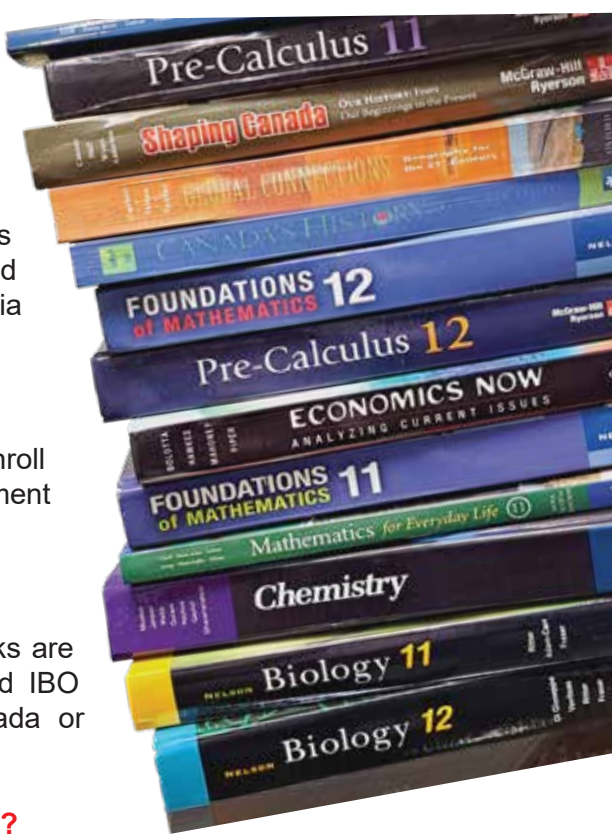
- Research suitable universities
- Narrowing down the choices
- Application deadlines

Minimum academic requirements for university acceptance:

The majority of our students achieve academic excellence in their courses making it easier for them to be admitted to universities. The minimum required grade for admission into most universities is 80% in core courses such as Mathematics and English. On the other hand, IB diploma is highly sought after pre-university qualification by the prestigious universities around the world.

Where are our graduates studying now?

A high number of our graduates are studying in universities in Canada. We also have students gaining admission to universities around the world such as USA, Australia, Malaysia, Turkey, Bangladesh, Japan, and UK.



What is the chance of getting a scholarship?

Many of our graduates achieve scholarships in different universities. We support the process for attaining academic qualification. Our admission counselors guide them through the scholarship process making sure they have the necessary documents to support their application.

Whether the students can work while studying?

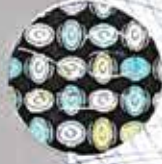
Yes, the students can work and gain financial aid during their university program. However, it is necessary they maintain and respect the country's rules, regulations, and guidelines.
